Somers SEPTA Achievement Scholarship Amount Up to \$1000

Requirements:

Recipient must be a graduating senior who is attending a two, or four year college, trade or vocational school.

Recipient has volunteered with individuals with disabilities during their time as a student at Somers High School.

Recipient's parent or legal guardian does not have to be a SEPTA member.

Recipient must answer the questions below in either essay form, or by making a DVD/video, verbally explaining your answers.

- 1) Select three words that best describe yourself and provide examples of why these characteristics fit.
- 2) Discuss why you became involved with individuals with disabilities and explain how this experience has impacted you, and how you have benefited from it.

Please submit a Letter(s) of Recommendation from the organization(s) you have volunteered with. Please include the time period in which you were involved and the approximate number of hours spent in this position.

Please discuss your plans for next year, and what career you hope to pursue.

Submit a Letter of Acceptance from the school you will be attending.

Please include a Cover Letter with your Letter of Acceptance, essay or DVD. Your Cover Letter should include your name, phone number, mailing address and email address. Please also include your parent or legal guardian's name and phone number.

Please submit your Cover Letter, Acceptance Letter, essay or DVD to the College and Career Center by May 11, 2018.
