

SHS CHAMBER CHOIR AND ORCHESTRA TOUR OF CANADA

Make sure you remember to pack the following items:

PASSPORT (and a secure place to keep it)

Medical insurance card

Traveler's checks or credit card

Music Binder – must be **BLACK**, with all music hole-punched within, and **PENCIL**

Concert Attire:

Men – “tuxedo look” – white shirt, bowtie, black jacket and pants, **BLACK** socks, and black dress shoes. Consider packing an extra shirt, bowtie, and socks.

Women – Red Chamber Choir gown. Black flat or low heels advisable.

Hanging bag for concert attire

Walking shoes or sneakers – **IMPERATIVE**

Bathing suit – you never know

Carry-on bag

Winter jacket, hat, gloves - **IMPERATIVE**

Folding umbrella

Jeans

Decent pants (men)

One dress or skirt (women) or slacks

Toiletries, cosmetics, tissues, bandaids. Medication?

An excellent attitude

Check with roommates to share hair dryers, etc.

Pack liquid items (shampoo, etc.) in zip-loc bags, otherwise, they might spill within your suitcases

CELL PHONE/OTHER ELECTRONIC USE WILL BE RESTRICTED AND/OR FORBIDDEN AT TIMES

Leave home:

Expensive items (jewelry, etc.)

Baseball caps – frequently, the wearing of hats would be inappropriate

Flip flops or summer shoes – you will **FREEZE**

Any clothing that would be in poor taste. Please remember that we will be visiting cathedrals, museums, schools, and will be eating in restaurants daily.

**** A WORD ABOUT EMERGENCY FUNDS: YOUR CHILD MUST HAVE A CREDIT CARD TO BE USED IN CASE OF EMERGENCIES. CANADIAN HOSPITALS OFTEN REQUIRE TO BE PAID AT THE TIME OF THE VISIT. THE PATIENT MAY LATER SUBMIT THE BILL FOR REIMBURSEMENT FROM INSURANCE.**
