HOW DO I GET ON THE BALLOT?

- o Hand in the paperwork by 10/11.

- o Attend 1 additional Class Representative meeting for your grade prior to Election Day. This will be at lunch.
- o Start a campaign and design 25 approved fliers to hang around the school on Campaign week.
- o Take Action today!!!!

Rules for your posters

- o 1. They must be on a 11x8.5 paper
- o 2. They may not include anything inappropriate
- o 3. You may only hang 25
- o 4. You may only hang them up with masking tape provided by Mr. Arnett. See him after Mrs. Gottlieb approves your posters.
- o 5. You may not hang any signs on walls that are painted, they must be hung on tiles, glass, wood, etc.
- o 6. You can hang posters from 10/30-11/7
- o 7. Winning representatives will take down the posters on 11/8.

Campaign Week

- Posters can be hung anytime during campaign week. 10/30-11/7
- Speeches will be given at lunch on 11/6 in the Auditorium
- Each student will get 90 seconds to share their "Letter of Intent and Resume" however they see fit. They must read directly from their approved "Letter and Intent and Resume"
- Ballots will be given out on 11/7 in Social Studies classes.
- Student Council will tally the votes and the winners will be announced on the morning announcements 11/8.
