

Accessing PSAT 2022 Scores

For all sophomores and juniors who took the PSAT on October 15, 2022, College Board announced scores will be released on Monday, December 5, 2022. Below is a step-by-step guide to retrieving your scores on the [College Board website](#).

- Students must first create an account (if they have not previously done so) on the [Students Score Reports](#) page in order to access their results. Make sure you keep a record of your login information, as you will use this same account later on to register for the SAT, as well as view your results and submit them to colleges. If you have already created an account, head to the reports page and log in from there.
- Once the account has been successfully created, students will either see their score report automatically, or be taken to a page titled “Don’t See Your Scores?” If you do not see your scores, click the “Matching Tool” link on the page, followed by the “Get My Scores” button on the following page.
- You will now be asked to enter an access code – this code can be obtained from Mr. Fleck or Mrs. Cominsky in the Counseling Center, either in person, or delivered electronically to students’ Schoology accounts.
- You should now be able to see your score report. There is a wealth of information on there that might get confusing to look at. College Board has provided a [Guide to Understanding Scores](#) to help break down and understand what your scores mean and some next steps.
