

## SHS Schedule Highlights

Day 4 9-9-19

Today was another great day at SHS. We are hearing lots of positive feedback from students, parents, and staff. We will continue to work through the critical feedback to make things better. Here are some of the highlights and reminders for both students and parents:

- My child tells me that by the time he/she gets lunch, there isn't enough time to eat. The only way this would be true is if your child waits until much later in the period. We ask that kids trust that there is plenty of time during the period to get on line, order their food, and eat. If they are worried about not having enough time, then they can always use the Nurtislice App to pre-order and skip waiting in line.
- Where can my child go if they want a quiet space? The Library has created quiet spaces for students who want to work/study. They can use the Glassroom (when available) and the Conference Room. In addition, students can go to the Academic Support Center and the College and Career Center.
- What are the procedures for seniors who wish to leave campus during Community Lunch? Seniors must present their Senior ID's when leaving and re-entering the building during Community Lunch and during any other free period. Only seniors with a valid Late Arrival, Early Dismissal or Off-Campus form can leave campus during the day.
- Can juniors arrive late or leave early if they have free? No. These privileges are reserved for seniors only who have a valid form on file, signed by a parent. All other students are expected to be on campus at all times, unless signed in/out by a parent with a valid legal excuse.
- How will students know which classes will meet on a ½ PLC Day? All 8 courses that a student has will meet on a ½ PLC Day, however, we will notify students ahead of time which day of the cycle they should follow.
