

## SHS Schedule Highlights

Today was another great day. We are running out of things to share, but will continue these highlights through tomorrow, the end of the 1st cycle. After that, we'll only share highlights of the new schedule as they come up. Once again, we keep hearing such great feedback from students, parents, and staff. Many have us have walked around the school during Community Lunch and we see groups of students, sitting with their friends and chatting, laughing, playing basketball, etc. They are finding their places to go and there is such a great positive vibe throughout the building, everywhere you go. Also, outside of the Community lunch period, the hallways are quiet and there is a calmness that seems to have swept through the building.

- Is there a way for my child to easily see what classes they have on a given day? If students are using the Infinite Campus APP, it will show them all the classes they have for that day at the appropriate time. This really helps facilitate students knowing where they are supposed to be at any given time.
- What classes will parents visit on Open House? We will be sending home information next week regarding Open House and the classes and schedule parents will follow. Students will be filling out blank schedules during their 1st period classes on 9/23 and will bring those home for parents. If a student doesn't have a 1st period class on Day 6, we will ask them to do it during their 2nd period class. Schedules will also be available the night of Open House in the Main Office. Parents will be visiting all classes on their child's schedule.
- How are school pictures working this year? Underclass pictures will be taking place on September 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>. Students will go to the Auditorium with their English class, depending on which day of the cycle their English class meets. September 23<sup>rd</sup> is a Day 6 and September 24<sup>th</sup> is a Day 7.
- How are off-campus privileges working for seniors? Our seniors who leave campus for lunch or during a free period have been awesome. They have been incredibly mature and responsible and they have quickly grown accustomed to showing their ID's upon exit and arrival to the building. They are also proving themselves to be responsible by returning to school in time to attend their next class. As a reminder, ONLY those seniors with approved forms on file are permitted to leave during the school day and underclass students can never leave campus without parent permission and for a valid reason.
