

SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

The dates of regular Board of Education meetings shall be established at the annual organizational meeting. In the event that the day appointed for a regular meeting shall fall on a legal holiday, the meeting shall be rescheduled. All regular Board meetings are open to the public.

All regular meetings of the Board will be held in a district building with a public session beginning at 7:00 p.m.

Any change in time or place will be established by the Board President, in which case Board members shall be given notice not less than twenty-four hours in advance. Public notice of such change shall be given within the statutory requirements for such notice.

In addition to the members of the Board, the following individuals will regularly attend the business meetings of the Board:

1. Superintendent of Schools;
2. Assistant Superintendent; and
3. Directors of Elementary Education, Secondary Education, Personnel; and
4. Other specified personnel as deemed necessary.

If a Board member is not present at the opening of a meeting, the subsequent arrival time of such member shall be indicated in the minutes.
