

DISPLAYING THE FLAG AND LOCAL COMMEMORATIVES

The flag of the United States shall be raised to full staff above each schoolhouse and at other appropriate places during all school sessions and on all legal school holidays, weather permitting, each general election day and each day appointed by the President of the United States or the Governor of this state. The flag shall be raised before the opening of school and taken down at its close every day.

Mourning

The flag of the United States shall be flown at half-staff on the grounds of the Somers schools during special periods of mourning when such action is directed by the laws of the United States or the State of New York; proclamation of the President of the United States or the Governor of New York; or by direction of the Superintendent of Schools with the concurrence of the President of the Board of Education; or, in the absence of the Superintendent, by order of the President of the Board of Education.

Special Days and Events

Commemoration of special days and events shall be arranged to the end that the effective observation of these occasions will be a valuable part of the school program.
