2020/2021 SCHOOL BUDGET VOTE & TRUSTEE ELECTION

- Per Governor's Executive Order, Ballots will be sent via US Mail no later than June 2nd to all residents who are registered to vote.
- Ballots must be completed, inserted in Oath Envelope that is provided. Voter must seal and sign the back of the envelope. Oath Envelope then needs to be inserted in pre-paid, pre-addressed envelope to the District Clerk.
- Ballots cannot be counted without a signature.
- Ballots must be received in the District office at Somers Middle School no later than 5pm on June 9th.





School Budget Vote and Trustee Election

The School Budget Vote and Election will take place by mail-in ballot. A ballot will be mailed to each qualified voter of the school district. For the vote to be counted, the ballot must be received in the District Clerks' office no later than 5:00 P.M. on June 9, 2020.

Qualified voters of the School District will receive ballots by mail.

To be a qualified voter you must be a U.S Citizen, at least 18 years old by June 9, 2020, a School District resident for 30 days immediately preceding the vote, and registered to vote in School District elections and having voted in any School District election/vote during the past 4 calendar years.
